C. ATHLETE ELIGIBILITY

C.1 Compliance with the Constitution and Rules of Olympic Council of Asia and other relevant rules

All athletes must respect and comply with the Constitution and Rules of Olympic Council of Asia (“Rule”) currently in force.

Only those athletes who respect and comply with the Rules, the World Anti-Doping Code, and the Olympic Movement Code on the Prevention of the Manipulation of Competitions, including the conditions of participation established by the OCA, plus the rules of the ASF, may participate in the Asian Games Aichi-Nagoya 2026.

C.2 Additional AF eligibility criteria

To be eligible to participate in the ASF Asian Surfing Games and Asian Games Aichi-Nagoya 2026, all athletes must:

- Be in good standing with his/her National Federation (“NF”) and the ASF in accordance with the ISA Rule Book in force at the time of the ASF Asian Surfing Championships or the Asian Games.
